During the pivot to online teaching for all programmes, Tom collaboratively constructed clear and direct guidance not only on the practicalities of online teaching but also on the ethos of approaches. This facilitated teaching staff that were self-motivated in their development of online pedagogies , and also with those that needed additional support (both self-declared, and also crucially those highlighted by managers as struggling to engage). This additional support was provided with pro-active, direct training both by himself and members of his team. The ability to engage those that lacked confidence (and by extension struggled initially to engage with online learning) is a strength Tom has demonstrated through this supportive approach, and is evidenced by the delivery quality during, and subsequently after, the pivot (and extensive teaching staff feedback directly on Tom and his team). His subsequent leadership within developing the next stages of online learning (with the move to considerable online teaching in the academic year 20/21) has demonstrated a strategic approach which has shaped the online pedagogic narrative for the Faculty.
